What is it?

A club established by Stryker to support orthopaedic registrars throughout their training years.

Why join?

It provides you access to a variety of educational resources and training tailored to your needs.

Argo member entitlements

- Free AU\$100 textbook voucher on joining the program.
- Evening seminars on topics which will include 'fellowship opportunities', 'good clinical research' and 'statistics for surgeons'. Dates will be provided on joining.
- Free accommodation (2 nights) to attend any Stryker Basic Principles Course. These are two day national courses which cover general hip, knee or trauma topics and involve hands on training as well as expert panel sessions.
- Free registration to attend any of the following Stryker symposia: OrthoPacific (20-25 Aug 2005), Stryker Hip Symposium (28-30 April 2005), Stryker Spine Symposium (27-29 May 2005).
- Access to the Stryker fellowship handbook and travelling assistance awards.
- Fellowship relocation advice including pre departure planning and rental searches at any Stryker fellowship site in the UK.
